TEA PLANTATION TOUR

The tea plantations of the Cameron Highlands are one of the most beautiful areas of mainland Malaysia and offer stunning views and a welcome break from the heat of Kuala Lumpur. The team will have the opportunity to visit the tea plantations to learn about the tea industry.

WHITE WATER RAFTING

The team will travel to Batu Gajah for a day of white water rafting (maximum grade 3). This is a great way to see this beautiful environment from a new perspective and also works to develop team work skills. You will then enjoy a BBQ on the banks of the river followed by a camp out.

TURTLE PROJECT

The Turtle Conservation Society of Malaysia is dedicated to the restoration of habitats of turtles. The team will get the opportunity to undertake a 3 day project which will involve hands-on conservation work and a comprehensive introduction to turtle conservation in Malaysia.

CULTURAL EXPLORATION
